Connemara is an Irish based Exploration Company, with interests in zinc and gold exploration. The company holds over 30 Irish licenses and has some of the most prospective ground in Ireland.

In gold Connemara holds 16 licences, 5 in Wicklow/Wexford in joint venture with Hendrick and 11 in Donegal. Currently Connemara has a gold discovery on the Inishowen licence block in Donegal. Connemara holds 19 licences prospective for zinc.

A significant zinc discovery was made on the Connemara licences at Stonepark in Limerick. Connemara has further licenses close to the former Lisheen zinc mine in Thurles and in Oldcastle, with similar geology to Tara Mines 20 km away. The Stonepark and Oldcastle licences, eleven in total, are joint ventured with Teck of Canada.

Additional zinc licences are held in Laois, Tipperary and Cork






Connemara Ground

Operations

Stonepark Block - Connemara and Teck made a significant zinc discovery at Stonepark in Limerick in 2007. The discovery is adjacent to the Glencore Pallas Green deposit containing 42 million tonnes of 8% combined zinc/lead. Two additional discoveries were made, Stonepark North and Stonepark West. A total of 135 holes have been drilled. There is interest in the block from other mining companies. The average grade of the discoveries to date is in excess of 11% combined zinc/lead. Connemara holds 23%.



Oldcastle Block — Five contiguous licences located in counties Cavan and Meath, with strong drilling results from earlier drilling. The geology is similar to Tara Mines 20 km away. Joint venture with Teck who are spending €1.35m for 75%. Seismic completed. Drilling in 2016 found traces of mineralisation. The targets are deep. Support for the model has been received from the recent high grade deep discovery at Tara.



Oldcastle Block

Inishowen Blocks – 11 gold licences on the Donegal peninsula of Inishowen. Successive exploration campaigns have identified a series of parallel gold bearing veins in a small area. Three drilling programmes identified the veins. Initial drilling intercepted 4.82 m @ 5.48g/t over 2 high grade narrow veins.

Wicklow/Wexford Gold Block — Five contiguous licences in Wexford and Wicklow. Connemara holds an extensive gold database. A joint venture is ongoing with Hendricks Resources, a Canadian exploration company. Hendricks can acquire up to 75% for €1m. New drill targets have been identified following extensive sampling and geophysics.
